

Delegates to the 2019 KEA Delegate Assembly will be elected at the Student Program Fall Conference, October 5 & 6, 2018.

The Kentucky Education Association's annual Delegate Assembly (DA) is the highest decision-making body of the organization. More than 600 delegates—all chosen by their colleagues in local and district elections—meet for three days at the Marriott Hotel in downtown Louisville to debate the vital issues that affect Kentucky's public schools and set Association policy for the coming year.

For Student Program members, the DA is a wonderful opportunity to interact with professional educators from every county in the Commonwealth and learn about our public schools from the people who make them work.

Join fellow student members, teachers, retired educators and education support professionals to help shape the future of KEA and Kentucky's public schools.

Student Program Delegates to the 2019 KEA Delegate Assembly will be elected at the Student Program Fall Conference, October 5 & 6, 2018.

Nominations will be taken during the evening business session on Friday, October 5th.

Delegates will be elected Saturday, October 6th.

The final number of delegates allocated to KEA SP will depend on our membership, but we expect to have 9 to 11 delegates.

Nominees will be ranked by votes received. Nominees who are not elected to one of the initial delegate positions will be alternates. If necessary, additional alternates may be elected at the Student Program Winter Conference.

The Student Program will pay for delegates' hotel rooms and mileage to and from Louisville. Dates of KEA DA – April 3-5, 2019.

Student delegates are expected to attend the entire DA.
